

**CODICILS TO THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT
OF
WILLIAM BARLOW**

Born Wigan, Lancashire 12 March 1802
Died Swansea, Tasmania 3 October 1883

Codicil No 1 to the Will of William Barlow of The Hermitage 20th December 1879

It is my desire that the furniture and the utensils of the house at my decease shall be sold and equally divided between my wife and daughter Mary. The Executors previous to this sale shall allow Mrs Mary Ann Barlow my wife, to select such furniture as she may choose to furnish a small bedroom. The Cassells Illustrated Bible which contains the Family Record shall fall to my only son William Barlow. My watch with gold seal and key shall also fall to the lot of my son.

Codicil No 2 to the Will of William Barlow of The Hermitage 11th September 1882

It is my will and desire that at my decease that the Rent, 8 pound a year, for 209 acres of land at the Doctors Creek, Seymour, which is let to Joseph Badgegood, be paid to my present wife, Mary Ann Barlow, during her lifetime.

**Codicil No 3 to the Will of William Barlow of The Hermitage
11th September 1882**
